LUNCH FOR PRESCHOOLERS

\$60



During drought periods, many preschoolers come to school hungry. Nutritious school lunches improve health, energy and learning. \$60 covers lunch and medical check-ups for a preschooler for a year.

SMALL BUSINESS GRANTS

\$110



A small business grant, training, and support will provide a mom with sustainable income and food security for her family. \$110 grant ensures that a single mom can feed, clothe, and educate her children.

GOATS FOR LIVELIHOOD RECOVERY

\$65



During the drought, single moms had the greatest struggle to feed their children due to no crops, employment or livestock. \$65 buys one nanny goat to help a mom begin building a herd to feed her children better.

CROP INPUTS FOR PEACEMAKERS

\$55



Borana and Gabra farmers are returning to their village, destroyed by conflict, to plant fields together to alleviate hunger and to model reconciliation. \$55 will cover cost of ploughing an acre, maize and bean seed, and insect control.
