GOATS FOR LIVELIHOOD RECOVERY



During the drought, single moms had the greatest struggle to feed their children due to no crops, employment or livestock. \$65 buys one nanny goat to help a mom begin building a herd to feed her children better.

CROP INPUTS FOR PEACEMAKERS



Borana and Gabra farmers are returning to their village, destroyed by conflict, to plant fields together to alleviate hunger and to model reconciliation. \$55 will cover cost of ploughing an acre, maize and bean seed, and insect control.
